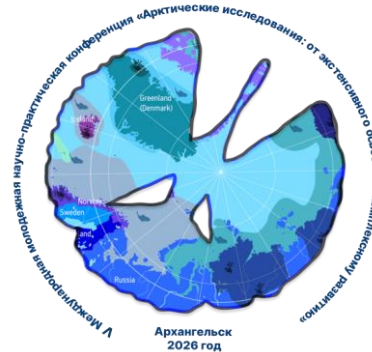

Guidelines for conference proceedings:

Please note, that one participant can submit **maximum two conference proceedings**, including the papers having multiple authors. It is a participant's responsibility to indicate his-her supervisor and co-authors (**maximum 5**). In case you have them, you are to present this information in the certain lines of registration form. Only materials presented as papers in sections may be published in the collection. The use of artificial intelligence in preparing materials is prohibited.

A text presented for the conference can be sent in electronic form using the standard MS Word (*.doc) format. **Name of the file** should correspond the author's last name alongside **with the number of chosen panel (e.g. 1-Petrov.doc)**.

Please use the Times New Roman font, Шрифт Times New Roman (12 pt.), single spacing, margins: 3 cm from the left, 1,5 cm from the right, upper and lower – 1,5 cm. indented line in the main text – 1,25 cm, justified alignment; all acronyms should be expanded in the text. Please note, that **at least 80%** of proceeding must be an **original text** prepared personally by the author.

A conference proceeding should not exceed the limit of 7 pages, including figures, tables, schemes obtaining numbers.

Title of the paper is given in the upper part of the document in **BOLD, using the capital letters**. The caption should be centered, with no paragraph indentation.

Lower, after one empty line skipped the author's (or authors') initials and last name should be given in *italics*. In the next line you should indicate your affiliation(s) and the city. This information is to be aligned along the left. Only the contact person's e-mail is to be given in the line after affiliation and a city name.

After one empty line left under the previous part, you should type your text in normal font and justified alignment.

Schemes and figures are given in the text of proceedings. Tables should have captions, figures should have captions under them. Caption of the table is given above it with the left alignment, without paragraph indentation and a hyphen between the number and the name (Table 1 – name). Font size in tables is 10-11 pt, single spacing. The word "Figure", its number and caption are given in the middle of the line divided with hyphen (Figure 1 – name). Caption is given under the figure, with justified alignment and no dot in the end.

Information on financing of the research is given in *italics* and corresponding to the recommended template: The research was made in the State assignment "(name of the project)" Ref. nr.: 122011300389-8 and with the RSCF financial support, project nr. 22-27-00190 "(name of the project)".

List of References is given after the text and separated from it with one empty line. Sources are to be indicated in the order you referred to them. References in the text are given as an order number in square brackets. Please make sure, that your list of References corresponds the example given below. The list should contain maximum **10-15** sources and should not exceed the limit of 1 page.

After the text you should give information about the author and organization, title of the paper, abstract, keywords and references in English.

The Organization committee has a right to reject the irrelevant proceedings and the materials, which do not correspond the styling guidelines.
